Outside my window, I could be looking at a morning in June with all the fog. If this weather continues it could be a dry year. Well, maybe we will get some rain out of this system tomorrow.

Next to the parking lot, we now have a beautiful compost receiving area. If you are not composting at home (or even if you are), please bring your home scraps in a bucket and dump them in the top door.

I have been studying materials on our new electric truck this last week, and am hoping to make some progress on getting it up and going soon. The only place that works on these vehicles is in Sacramento, and they are two months out in the schedule. So I am taking a crash course.

Everything in the field is moving forward. We have a fair amount of ground turned and are doing some large plantings of your favorites, like carrots. Be well.
